Why do you think you deserve to be a Clevite “Motorhead of the Month?”

We are a self-funded race team (of 2) so we work really hard building our own car, as well as do all our own public relations, public appearance and volunteer work. In Colorado we can only race between April and October so during those months we are at the drag strip 4-5 times a month. Since we are self-funded, traveling is an expense out of our own pocket so traveling as far as the east coast is impossible. But we are able to make 3-6 west coast events a season. With only the help of product sponsors, we were able to take a street Honda to an 11 second (should be 10 second this year) drag car. It is still a full body car, with full interior and a 4 cylinder engine making 550 whp.

Where do you buy your parts, and/or who builds your engine?

We build our own engine, and what parts aren't provided by sponsors, we buy wholesale from a distributor (we work at a performance shop)

Are you running Clevite/Perfect Circle/Victor Reinz parts in your motor?

We run Clevite bearings, gaskets, seals & cams.



Why do you think you deserve to be a Clevite “Motorhead of the Month?”

My love of cars goes back to when I was a small child and I've always always been a Clevite customer. The race team that I started, Follow A Dream races an Alcohol Funny Car in NHRA competition, a 526 cid Hemi that creates 3000 horsepower. The car accelerates from 0-250mph in 5 seconds. We run the car on the ragged edge, although we do try to stay on the right side of the edge.

Where do you buy your parts, and/or who builds your engine?

We purchase parts for the Funny Car from a variety of manufacturers and specialty suppliers. The cylinder block and heads are manufactured by Brad Anderson Enterprises out of Ontario, CA and our engines are all assembled in-house by our phenomenal tuner Tom Howell.

Are you running Clevite/Perfect Circle/Victor Reinz parts in your motor?

Yes, we run Perfect Circle® piston rings and Clevite® engine bearings, as their products can withstand the constant abuse we put them through.
